ORDER:

The Government have been examining the question of effecting a rational integration of the various Heads of Departments who are implementing Schemes on the Medical, Public Health and Family Welfare sides with a view to ensure Co-ordination, and effective lines of command, and also to optimise the use of resources. In order to achieve the above objectives, the Government have arrived at certain decisions and accordingly issue the following orders:-

STATE LEVEL

2. The Government direct that the Director, Primary Health Centres constituted as per the orders in G.O. Ms. No. 129, Health, dt: 28-1-1980 and the Directorate of Family Welfare, Constituted as per the orders in G.O. Ms. No. 1398, Health, dated: 23-8-1983 (as modified in G.O. Rt. No. 3716, Public (Special-A) Department dated 8-10-1983) be merged with the Directorate of Medical Services and that the integrated Directorate be designated as "Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services". The Director of the new Department shall be from the Medical Service cadre. Orders regarding posting of the Director will be issued separately.

3. The Government also direct that the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and Continuing Education, constituted as per the Orders in G.O. Ms. No. 1413, Health, dated: 12-7-1988 be merged with the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine. The integrated Department will be called the "Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine". The Director of the new department shall be from the Tamil Nadu Public Health Service Cadre.

DISTRICT LEVEL

4. Under the arrangements approved in G.O. Ms. No. 1032, Health, dated: 18-6-1990, as subsequently amended, the following three officers were assigned the lines of work specified against each at the Revenue District level.

5. Out of the above three officers, one Deputy Director will be from the Cadre of Medical Service and will be incharge of all the Medical institutions in the District. The other two Deputy Directors will be from the cadre of Public Health Service and will hereafter have georaphic jurisdiction and will be responsible for implementing the total Health and Family Welfare Programmes in the District. These two shall be designated as District Health Officers for statutory purposes. The areawise jurisdiction within each district will be demarcated by the Joint Director of Medical Services in the District.

6. The above orders at the State level will take effect from the dates of taking charge, after orders of posting are issued. At the district level, the new arrangements will take effect at the earlies as soon as the georgaphical allocation of jurisdiction for Deputy Directors in the Districts is settled.
