**APPENDIX  
NOTIFICATION.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Madras hereby makes the following rules.

**RULES.**

1. The General and Special Rules applicable to the holders of the Permanent posts in the Madras Public Health Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary post of Health Educator, Rural Health Scheme, Poonamallee, sanctioned in G.O. Ms. No: 236, Health, Education and Local Administration Department, dated the 29th January, 1957 subject to the modification specified in the following rules:-
2. Constitution: The post shall constitute a separate category in the said service.
3. Appointment: Appointment to the post shall be made by direct recruitment.
4. Appointing Authority: The appointing authority for the post shall be the Director of Public Health.
5. Age: No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless he has completed the age of 25 years and has not completed the age of 35 years on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is held;
6. Qualifications: No person shall be eligible for appointment unless he possesses:-
  - a. A certificate in Health Education of the All India Institute of Hygiene and Public Health, Calcutta, or other Institution recognised by the Central or the State Government or
