Notification

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following rules:-

The rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th February 1962.

Rules

The General and Special Rules applicable to the holders of permanent posts in the Madras Public Health Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary posts of Laboratory Technician sanctioned from time to time, for the Mobile Laboratory under the Epidemiological Unit and the Cholera Control Programme (Amendment issued in G.O. Ms.No.962 Health and Family Planning Department dt.15.4.75 in the Department of Health Services and Family Planning subject to the modifications specified in the following rules.

2. Constitution: The post shall constitute a separate category in a distinct class of the said service.

3. Appointment: Appointment to the post shall be made as follows:-

1. By promotion from among the holders of the post of Laboratory Attendants or Laboratory Assistants

or

By direct recruitment if no qualified and suitable candidates are available for promotion

4. Appointing Authority: The appointing authority for the post shall be the Assistant Director of Health Services and Family Planning (Malaria) amendment issued in G.O.Ms.No.962, dt.15.4.1975.

5. Qualifications: Age:- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete 25 years of age on the first of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is held.

b. other qualifications: No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless he possess the following qualifications namely:-

1. Must have passed PUC
2. Must have obtained a certificate of Laboratory Technology for Laboratory Technician Grade-I issued by the Director of Medical Education, Madras.

6. Probation: Every person appointed to the post of direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins the post, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty and a continuous period of three years.

7. Pay:- There shall be paid to the holder of the post of direct recruitment a monthly pay calculated in the scale of 90-4-110-3-140.

2. By direct recruitment if no qualified suitable candidates are available by transfer.
