ORDER

The posts of Computer-cum-Vaccine Store Keeper are filled up by recruitment by transfer from Junior Assistants belonging to the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service in the Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine. The persons who were appointed by transfer as Computer-cum-Vaccine Store Keeper from the post of Junior Assistant opt to go over to their regular line as and when they get their promotion in their regular line i.e. in Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service as there is no promotional avenue as of now for the post of Computer-cum-Vaccine Store Keeper. Further the post of Computer-cum-Vaccine Store Keeper is now outside the purview of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. As such the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has requested the Government to bring the post within the purview of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in order to get candidates with better calibre from open market and to issue amendment to adhoc rules. After careful examination the Government have decided to bring the post within the purview of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has stated that it has no remarks to offer to bring the post of Computer-cum-Vaccine Store Keeper within its purview and to issue amendment to adhoc rules. The Commission has however requested to issue necessary executive order bringing the post of Computer-cum-Vaccine Store Keeper within the commission's purview and to classify the post as Technical for the purpose of direct recruitment.

2. Accordingly the Government direct that the post of

Computer-cum-Vaccine Store Keeper be brought under the purview of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission and classified as "Technical" for the purpose of direct recruitment.

3. Necessary amendment to the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission regulations 1954 in this regard will be issued separately by the Government in Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department.

4. The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the rules published with the Health and Family Welfare Department Notification S.R.O. No.B.89/86, at pages 104 of Part III-Section I(b) of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the twelfth day of March, Nineteen eight six.

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force with effect on and from the 11th day of January 1996.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 5, for sub-rule (b), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

(b) Other Qualifications:- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless he possesses a degree in Statistics or a degree in Mathematics with Statistics as special subject.
