ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued formulating a scheme with effect from the financial year 1992-1993 to grant the following incentives to Drivers of the Government of Tamil Nadu, driving Government Vehicles who have rendered unblemished and accident free service subject to satisfying certain conditions as laid down therein:-

- (i) Award of small savings certificate for Rs.500/- to the Drivers who have completed 10 years of service;
- (ii) Award of Gold medal to the Drivers who have completed 20 years of service;

The above awards are subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) The Drivers who have rendered accident free service during a financial year and who have maintained the vehicles well as certified by the officer concerned using the vehicle and those Drivers who have shown higher kilometerage than the fuel consumption rate prescribed by the Government should be selected for the award. The officer using the vehicle should specifically recommend whether he considers the Driver fit for the award;
- 2) A performance sheet in the proforma as indicated in the Annexure to this order will be maintained for all the Drivers in addition to the Record Sheet;

- 3) A Driver will be eligible for each of the awards only once during his entire service.
2. In the G.O. 2nd read above, orders have been issued prescribing the procedures to be followed in the matter of awarding incentive description design and selecting authority of the medal.
3. In the Letter 3rd read above, the Director, Public Health and Preventive Medicines Department has requested to clarify as to how to award the Kisan Vikas Patra of Rs.500/- since the Government of India has discontinued the sale of Kisan Vikas Patra in its SB order No.22-2011, Letter No.113-01-2011, SB, dated 24.11.2011 with effect from 01.12.2011 consequent on rationalisation of scheme.
4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the above request and accordingly direct to issue a cash award of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) to the Drivers of the Government of Tamil Nadu, driving Government Vehicles who have rendered 10 years of unblemished and accident free service instead of awarding Kisan Vikas Patra for Rs.500/-.
5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.21222/CMPC/2014, dated 01.07.2014.


