In the Government Order first cited orders have been issued for the
constitution of Medical Services Recruitment Board to expedite the recruitment
of various categories of personnel for Health and Family Welfare Department.

In the reference third cited, Government have decided to implement the
Judgment of the High Court Judgment in W.A.No.1027 of 2013 and M.P.No.1
of 2013 dated 9.6.2014 in which it has been ordered that the State
Government should take immediate steps to fill up the posts by inviting
applications from all eligible persons by advertising in at least 2 Newspaper to
enable all the eligible persons and names sponsored by Employment Exchange
to compete for the posts.

In the reference fourth cited it has been informed by the Member Secretary,
Medical Services Recruitment Board, Chennai 6 that the post of Drivers and
posts classified under basic services have been exempted from the purview of
Medical Services Recruitment Board for direct recruitment.

The Officers noted in the despatch entry are requested to take action to fill
up the vacant post of drivers in Tamil Nadu Medical Subordinate Service and
Tamil Nadu Public Health Subordinate service by following the instructions
noted:

1. In the reference second cited, a copy of the Rules of Procedures of
Medical Services Recruitment Board for recruitment of various categories
of posts including drivers in Government Medical Institutions is enclosed.

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2. In the reference third cited orders of the Government issued for Implementation of High Court Judgment in W.A.No.1027 of 2013 and M.P.No.1 of 2013 dated 9.6.2014 and a copy is enclosed herewith.
3. A Committee chaired by the Deputy Director of Health Services should be constituted as below:

3. The Officers are requested to keep note of the following at the time of filling up of the drivers posts in the Health Unit District:
 - a. The driver posts sanctioned with time scale of pay for Newly Created Primary Health Centres for which appointments have not been done so far
 - b. Live posts of drivers for which salary can be claimed.
 - c. Availability of on road vehicles to the number of drivers recruited should be ensured.

The officers noted in the dispatch entry are hereby requested to take speedy action to fill up the vacant posts of drivers in time scale strictly adhering to the instructions above.

This may be treated as urgent and the receipt of the reference may be acknowledge of final report in the matter after selection of drivers is over may be intimated to this office.

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ORDER:

The Health and Family Welfare Department consists of more number of directorates under its control. Now appointment to various categories is being made by different modes of appointment. In the case of Direct Recruitment in Medical and Para Medical or Non-Medical category, the appointment is made either through Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission or through Employment Exchange. For a very long time, the Government have found it difficult to make appointments in a speedy manner, which affects the public especially the poor patients who approach the Government Hospital for treatment. Further medical services are essential services and keeping the posts vacant for a long time is not desirable in public interest. Therefore it is considered necessary to centralize the mode of direct recruitment by constituting a separate Recruitment Board for the Health and Family Welfare Department on the lines of the Teachers Recruitment Board.

2. At present, the doctors in Assistant Surgeon cadre are being recruited through Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. In the case of Para Medical category like Pharmacist and Laboratory Technician Grade II, a State wide Employment Exchange Seniority is being followed as in the case of Secondary Grade Teachers and accordingly orders were issued in Government Orders 2nd and 3rd read above. In respect of other

- (c) Sanction is accorded to create one post in DRO cadre with Pay Band III of Rs.15600-39100 + GP of Rs.7600/- with Recurring expenditure of nearly Rs.4.19 lakhs (Rupees Four lakhs nineteen thousand only) per annum.
- (d) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to identify posts of equal monetary value from among the directorates under Health and Family Welfare Department for matching surrender to the posts mentioned in para 3 (a) (ii) and (iv) above.

6. The Director of Medical and Rural Health* Services is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling Authority for the above new*sub head of account. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned are requested to open the above new head of account in their books.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. Orders regarding the sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to send an application in the prescribed form along with the copy of this order to Finance (BG-I) Department for sanctioning the advance for the required quantum. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is also directed to send necessary note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate for 2011-2012 to obtain the approval of the Legislature at the appropriate stage.



The Government order 1st read above orders have considered of Medical Services Recruitment Board (MSRB) Health and Family Welfare Department as to centralize the mode of recruitment to all categories available in Health and Family Welfare Department except those that are coming under the purview of Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. Subsequently in the Government order second read above Rules of Procedure of Medical Services Recruitment Board for recruitment to various categories have been issued.

2. The Chairman, Medical Services Recruitment Board (MSRB), has sent ahead the proposal to the Rules of Procedure to be followed for recruitment based on the Judgement dated 9.8.2014 of the Hon'ble High Court in WVA No. 1027/2013 and MP No 102013.

3. The Government have examined & order the proposal of the Chairman, Medical Services Recruitment Board (MSRB) to amend the Rules of Procedure of the Medical Services Recruitment Board, 2013 and has decided to accept it. Accordingly the following amendments are issued to the said Rules.

ORDER:

In the Government order 1st read above, orders have been issued for the constitution of Medical Services Recruitment Board exclusively for Health and Family Welfare Department so as to centralize the mode of direct recruitment to all categories existing in Health and Family Welfare Department except those that are coming under the purview of Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. Subsequently in the Government order second read above Rules of Procedures of Medical Services Recruitment Board for recruitment to various categories have been issued.

2. The Chairman, Medical Services Recruitment Board (MRB) has sent amendment proposal to the Rule of Procedure to be followed for recruitment based on the Judgement dated 9.6.2014 of the Hon'ble High Court in WA No.1027/2013 and MP No.1/2013.

3. The Government have examined in detail the proposal of the Chairman, Medical Services Recruitment Board (MRB) to amend the Rules of Procedure of the Medical Services Recruitment Board, 2013 and has decided to accept it. Accordingly the following amendments are issued to the said Rules:-

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Rules,- (1) for rule 3, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"3. Method of Recruitment.-

The Medical Services Recruitment Board shall adopt the following methods of recruitment, namely:-

(A) Recruitment by open advertisement.-

- (i) All Direct recruitment posts in Assistant Surgeon (General), Assistant Surgeon (Dental - General / Speciality) and Nurses shall be made, through open advertisement (in at least two newspapers and one of which must be in vernacular language), by conducting written examination (through physical or electronic mode) duly following the procedures prescribed.
- (ii) All direct recruitments to the post of Assistant Surgeon in various speciality Departments in Tamil Nadu Medical service shall be made through a 'walk-in' selection through open advertisement (in at least two newspapers and one of which must be in vernacular language), based on the marks obtained by the candidates in their Post Graduate Speciality subject. For the post of Assistant Surgeon (Speciality) a person in possession of Post graduate degree shall be preferred over DNB and DNB over a Post Graduate Diploma duly following the procedures prescribed.
- (iii) Para Medical & Technical Staff with following educational qualifications, namely:-
All direct recruitments to the post of Paramedical and technical staff shall be done through a selection process based on open advertisement (in at least two newspapers and one of which must be in vernacular language), along with notifying the vacancies with the Employment Exchange. After obtaining eligible list sponsored by the Employment Exchange, open advertisement in at least two newspapers, (one of which must be in vernacular language) be published inviting application. The list of candidates sponsored by the Employment Exchange be intimated to apply for the concerned post, as per the advertisement, to the Medical Services Recruitment Board. The process of selection shall be based on the marks obtained by the candidates in various examinations by giving weightages to their academic performance (up to two decimals in percentage) as detailed below:

(NA - Not Applicable)

- (a) Wherever the basic essential qualification for a technical post is a diploma / certificate, has been changed from SSLC to HSC, in all such cases the weightage may be restricted to marks obtained in SSLC and the technical diploma / certificate (instead of HSC and the technical diploma / certificate).
- (b) In cases of lesser number of vacancies for a particular post, and in cases where the notified vacancies are pertaining only to one or few districts only, the notified vacancies may be sent to the District Employment Exchanges concerned instead of the State level Employment Exchange.
- (c) In cases where recruitment is to be done on an urgent basis, Government may specifically direct the Medical Services Recruitment Board to conduct recruitment by only way of open advertisement (in at least two newspapers, one of which must be in vernacular language).

iv) Selection process for Driver recruitment through open advertisement.

All direct recruitments to the post of Drivers be done by way of open advertisement from eligible candidates, apart from notifying the vacancies with the Employment Exchange. After obtaining the list sponsored by the Employment Exchange, open advertisement in at least two newspapers, one of which must be in vernacular language be published inviting application. The list of candidates obtained from Employment Exchange need to be addressed to file an application (online) to the Medical Services Recruitment Board for the post of Driver.

- (1) Qualifications.- No person shall be eligible to appoint to the post, unless he possesses the following qualifications, namely:-
- (a) Educational Qualification,- As per Adhoc rules.
- (b) A valid Driving License to drive Transport Vehicles (Heavy Motor Vehicles)
- (c) Nativity Certificate from the Appropriate Revenue Authority.
- (d) Experience of minimum 2 years after obtaining the licence for driving Heavy Motor Vehicles / Transport Vehicles.
- (e) Knowledge in vehicle maintenance / Traffic Rules etc.
(Written Test) by physical or electronic mode - (100% weightage for selection) subject to the following:
- (i) Physical Fitness Certificate including Vision Certificate.
- (ii) shall pass the On Road Test Driving (conducted by the Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department)
- (v) In addition, with the previous sanction of the Government, the Medical Services Recruitment Board can recruit the candidates by any other means as specifically approved by Government in this regard.

(vi) Age Limit:

As furnished in the Special Rules / Adhoc Rules of the post to which the recruitment is made”;

(2) in rule 4, for sub-rule(ii), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:

“(ii) The Board shall call for the list of suitable candidates for future vacancies through open advertisement or other means approved by the Government, as the case may be. The Medical Services Recruitment Board shall recruit candidates duly following the procedure prescribed in rule 3. Method of Recruitment in this regard, on merit and duly applying rules of reservation and other priorities assigned through specific order of the Government.”;

(3) for rule 5, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:

“5. Collection of particulars from the candidates.-

The Medical Services Recruitment Board shall call for copies of photographs of the candidates and such other particulars as may be required and specified in such form by the Medical Services Recruitment Board as well as the originals of certificates of Educational Qualifications, date of birth and any other certificates / documents of relevance to the recruitment, so as to verify the eligibility / suitability of the candidates. The applications may be called for either by physical or electronic means. The Medical Services Recruitment Board shall cause further verification of documents / certificates, from the competent authorities, if deem necessary.”

(4) for rule 6, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:

“6. Method of Selection and Seniority of Selected Candidates.-

(A) The Medical Services Recruitment Board shall select candidates who fulfil the qualification as per the rules / norms governing the post:

(i) **For candidates recruited through open advertisement:-** The selection of eligible candidates who fulfil the qualification criteria shall be on the basis of rank / marks obtained in the written examination or duly following the procedure of merit approved in this regard, duly applying rules of reservation and other priorities assigned through specific orders of the Government.

(B) The candidates selected as per sub-rule A (i) above shall be assigned seniority as in the same order of selection.

(C) In the event of two or more candidates scoring equal marks in the written examination, (or) by any other means of merit the following will be the basis of selection or fixing of seniority.

(a) Senior in age shall be placed above:

- (b) If the age too, is equal, the following will be the basis of fixing the seniority.
 - (i) In case of Optical Mark Reader (OMR) (Offline) applications, the date of receipt of application in the Medical Services Recruitment Board's office shall be taken into account to fix the seniority.
 - (ii) In case of Online applications, the date and time of online registration of application shall be taken into account to fix the seniority."

ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, the Government have ordered that all temporary appointments and appointments which do not fall under the purview of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission should be filled up by recruitment through the Employment Exchanges only. Any other form of recruitment can be resorted to, only after obtaining a non-availability certificate from the Employment Exchange concerned.

2. In the G.O. 2nd read above, the Government have ordered that all the Industries, Institutions, Universities, Colleges, Schools, Hostels, Orphanages, Co-operative Societies etc. which receive financial assistance by way of grant or loan or material assistance etc., from this Government or State quasi-Government Institutions, Statutory Corporations, Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous Boards, Co-operative Institutions etc. should recruit its personnel only through Employment

(p.t.o)

Exchanges by way of notifying the vacancies to the concerned Employment Exchange in the manner and form prescribed under the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of vacancies) Rules, 1960 and resort to any other form of recruitment like advertisement in Dailies etc., only after obtaining a "Non-availability Certificate" from the concerned Employment Exchange or obtaining the prior sanction of Government through the financial institutions or Government Department, in the administrative Departments of the Secretariat in consultation with the Labour and Employment Department in the Government.

3. In the High Court order 3rd read above, the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in its Order dated 02.08.2012 in W.P.No.26162 of 2010 and M.P.No.1 of 2010 has quashed the selection process for appointment to the posts only from candidates sponsored through Employment Exchanges and has ordered that the State Government should take immediate steps to fill up the posts by inviting applications from all eligible persons along with names sponsored by the Employment Exchange by advertising in newspapers and other media to enable all the eligible persons to compete for the posts. The observation of the Hon'ble High Court in the said order is as follows:

"A writ in the nature of mandamus is issued directing the respondents to advertise the posts in all leading newspapers and other media to enable all the eligible persons to compete for the post. The advertisement should show the number of posts to be filled up, the qualification for the post. The age limit and relaxation in age if any. The post reserved for different categories. The respondents should also constitute selection committee, who shall adopt the criteria of selection before commencement of selection process laying down marks for qualification, experience, interview, etc. depending on the post to be filled up.

In view of the different Government orders placed on record, it is directed that the State Government should take immediate steps to fill up the posts, by inviting applications from all eligible persons, along with names sponsored by the Employment Exchange after laying down criteria for selection, so as to select best available talent."

4. The Director of Employment and Training has filed appeal in Writ Appeal No. 1027 of 2013 and M.P.No.1 of 2013 against the aforesaid Order, dated 02.08.2012 in W.P.No 26162 of 2010 and M.P.No.1 of 2010.

5. In the High Court Judgment 5th read above, the Hon'ble High Court has dismissed the Writ Appeal filed by the Director of Employment and Training, reiterating that posts should be filled up by issuing advertisement in atleast 2 newspapers out of which one must be in vernacular language having wide circulation in the respective State, apart from calling for list from the Employment Exchange in order to comply with Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India and ordered that "Registry is directed to forward the copy of the judgment forthwith to the Chief Secretary to the Government of Tamil Nadu, who in turn directed to circulate the copy of the judgement to all the Secretaries of various departments, for strict compliance".

In the letter 6th read above, the Director of Employment and Training has requested the Government to issue suitable orders on the implementation of the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in Writ Appeal No. 1027 of 2013 and M.P.No.1 of 2013 dated 09.06.2014 against the order dated 02.08.2012 in W.P.No.26162 of 2010 and M.P.No.1 of 2010.

7. The Government have examined this issue in detail. After careful examination, the Government have decided to implement the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court in W.A.No.1027 of 2013 and M.P.No.1 of 2013 dated 09.06.2014 (W.P.No.26162 of 2010 and M.P.No.1 of 2010). Accordingly all the Additional Chief Secretaries / Principal Secretaries / Secretaries of the Departments of Secretariat are directed to adhere to the judgment delivered in the W.A.No.1027 of 2013 and M.P.No.1 of 2013 dated 09.06.2014 (W.P. No.26162 of 2010 and M.P.No.1 of 2010) while filling up the posts under their control.
