ALLOWANCES - Dearness Allowance - Enhanced Rates effective from 1st July 1996 - Orders - Issued.

Order--No.626, Finance(Allowances), dated 25th September 1996.

In the Government order read above, orders were issued sanctioning revised rates of Dearness Allowance to the State Government employees as detailed below:-

Date from which payable	Pay Range	Rates of D.A. (per mensem)
1st January 1996	Upto Rs.3,500/-	148 per cent of pay.
	Above Rs.3,500/-	111 per cent of pay subject to a minimum of Rs.5,180/-.

2. The Government of India have now sanctioned revised rates of Dearness Allowance to their employees with effect from 1st July 1996 as follows:-

Date from which payable	Pay Range	Revised rates of D.A. (per mensem)
1st July 1996	(i) Basic pay upto Rs.3,500/- p.m.	159 per cent of pay.

Date from which payable	Pay Range	Revised rates of D.A. (per mensem).
1st July 1996	(ii) Basic pay above Rs.3,500/- p.m. and upto Rs.6,000/- p.m.	119 per cent of pay, subject to a minimum of Rs.5565/-.
	(iii) Basic pay above Rs.6,000/- p.m.	103 per cent of pay, subject to a minimum of Rs.7140/-.

3. Following the orders issued by Government of India, in their Office Memorandum second read above, the Government now sanction the revised rates of Dearness Allowance to the State Government Employees as follows:-

Date from which payable	Pay Range	Revised rates of D.A. (per mensem)
1st July 1996	Upto Rs.3,500/-	159 per cent of pay.
	Above Rs.3,500/-	119 per cent of pay, subject to a minimum of Rs.5,565/-.


4. The Government has decided that the increase in Dearness Allowance shall be paid in cash to all the employees irrespective of pay drawn by them with effect from 1st July 1996. The details of admissibility of revised Dearness Allowance for employees drawing pay at various stages are given in the Annexure to this Order.

5. For the purpose of calculation of revised Dearness Allowance, the basic pay including personal pay, if any, shall be taken into account. In cases, where the pay plus personal pay of Government servants fall between two pay ranges indicated in column(i) in the Annexure to this order, the revised rates shall be worked out at the percentage rates. While working out the revised rate, fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to next higher rupee if such fraction is 50 paise and above and shall be ignored if it is less than 50 paise.

6. The Government also directs that the revised Dearness Allowance sanctioned above, shall be admissible to full time employees who are at present getting Dearness Allowance and paid from contingencies at fixed monthly rates and to full time non-provincialised work-charged establishments. The revised rates of Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this order shall not be admissible to part time employees.

7. The revised Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this order will also apply to the teaching and non-teaching staff working under the local bodies and in aided educational institutions, employees governed by the University Grants Commission and the All-India Council of Technical Education scales of pay and the Teachers/Physical Directors/Librarians in Government and Aided Polytechnics, Special Diploma Institutions and Village Assistants in Revenue Department.

8. The expenditure shall be debited to the detailed head of account '03 Dearness Allowance' under the relevant sub, minor, sub-major and major heads of account.



9. The Treasury Officers/Pay and Accounts Officers are requested to make payment of the revised Dearness Allowance when bills are presented without waiting for the authorisation from the Principal Accountant-General (A. & E.).
