ORDER

The Deputy Director of Health Service is the appointing authority for both the post of Drivers in Primary Health Centres which comes under Tamil Nadu Medical Subordinate Service and the post of Drivers in his office which comes under the Tamil Nadu Public Health Subordinate Service. When a Primary Health Centre vehicle goes off the road instead of keeping the services of the Driver of that vehicle idle, the services of such Driver are utilised in Deputy Director of Health Services offices if the post of driver in the Public Health side is vacant there and vice versa, on the presumption that Drivers can be transferred from the Deputy Director of Health Service office side to Primary Health Centres side and vice versa. The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has, therefore, requested the Government to ratify the action of the former District Health Officers (now the Deputy Directors of Health Services) in having transferred the Drivers appointed in Primary Health Centre side to Deputy Director of Health Service Offices or vice versa to fill up vacant posts in the interest of administration as a special case and also issue necessary amendment to special rule for the post of Driver to the effect that the post of Driver is interchangeable from Primary Health Centre side to general side and vice versa on the administrative convenience.

2. The Government have examined the request of the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine. The transfer of a person from one service to another service will be construed as appointment by recruitment by transfer. If the special rule for the post of Driver is amended as requested by the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine, a person appointed in one service on transfer is posted to another service can not be brought back to the original service again on administrative convenience. The intention of the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine is to empower the Deputy Director of Health Service to make the transfer of

Drivers from Primary Health Centre side to general side and vice versa without changing the service in which they are appointed on administrative convenience. This can be done without amending the special rule for the post of Driver. Hence the Government permit the Deputy Director of Health Services to make the transfer of Drivers from Primary Health Centre side to general side and vice versa on diversion subject to the condition that the service of the Drivers in which they are appointed should not be changed. The Government also ratify the action of those Deputy Director of Health Services in having transferred the Drivers from Primary Health Centre side to General side and vice versa as a special case subject to the fulfilment of the condition mentioned above.
