

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ORDER:

The Controller of Examinations, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has stated that the rates of remuneration now paid to the examiners etc. appointed by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission which were fixed in 1989 were least attractive, and the Commission found it almost impossible to get examiners at the existing rates. In order to attract the right type of persons for work, the Commission has sent proposals for the revision of the rates of remuneration payable to examiners etc.

2. The Government have examined the proposals of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in detail and they direct that the rates of remuneration of examiners for setting question papers, for valuing answer papers, and for Invigilators of the written examinations conducted by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, be revised as follows:-
