Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Family Security Fund Scheme - Enhancement of the lumpsum payment from Rs.60,000/- to Rs.1,00,000/- - Orders - Issued.

READ -

G.O.Ms.No.531, Finance (Pension) Department, dated 19.7.1991.

ORDER:

In the Government Order read above, orders have been issued that under the Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Family Security Fund Scheme, a nominal monthly deduction of Rs.10/- (Rupees ten only) would be made from the pay of all Government servants till their superannuation and that in the case of death of a Government servant while in service, a sum of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand only) would be paid to his/her nominee. The Government have now decided as a measure of further support and security to the families of Government employees including employees on consolidated pay and honorarium, both part-time and full time, who die in harness, to enhance this lumpsum payment. They accordingly pass the following orders:

i) In the case of death of a Government servant while in service a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) shall be paid to his/her nominee.

ii) There shall be no change in the deduction of the existing contribution of Rs.10/- per mensem and the deduction will continue till the superannuation of the Government servants.

iii) The enhanced lumpsum payment shall come into force from 1st July 1996 (i. e) in respect of cases of death occurring on or after 1st July 1996.

iv) There shall be no change in the existing rules and other instructions governing the scheme.
