

Thadhu, Aani 7, Thiruvalluvar Aandu—2027

Pension—Payment of family pension to the children suffering from disorder or disability of mind or is physically crippled or disabled—Inclusion of names in Pension Payment Order—Orders issued—Revised Orders—Issued.

READ:—

- (1) G.O.Ms.No.635, Finance (Pension), dated 26th July 1994.
- (2) From the Director, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Madras-6 Letter R.C. No. D1/06853/95, dated 14th November 1995.

Order—No. 383, Finance (Pension), dated 21st June 1996.

According to the orders issued in the G.O. read above, Pension Payment Orders to be issued in future shall include all the members of the family including the disabled/mentally retarded/handicapped children. In the case of existing pensioners, if they desire, they shall send a list of eligible children to the Pension Sanctioning Authority *inter-alia* indicating whether any child is handicapped, mentally retarded or not. The receipt of the list has to be acknowledged by the Pension Sanctioning Authority and the acknowledgement has to be preserved by the members of the family of the pensioners.

2. The Director, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption in his letter read above has requested the Government that the orders issued in the G.O. read above may be modified suitably so as to enable the inclusion of the names of eligible family members also in the Pension Payment Order of the existing pensioners as and when applied by them.

3. The Government have carefully examined the above request of the Director, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption and decided to follow the procedure being adopted in the case of post retiral spouses. In modification of the orders issued in the G.O. read above, the Government direct that the following procedure be followed for endorsement of family pension entitlement of eligible children of pensioners:—

- (i) A pensioner shall furnish to the Head of Office/Head of Department concerned a list of the names of eligible children through the Pension Disbursing Authority *inter-alia* indicating whether any child is handicapped together with an attested copy of the certificate obtained from the Civil Surgeon in the case of children suffering from disorder or disability of mind or is physically crippled or disabled so as to render him/her unable to earn a living.
- (ii) The Head Office/Head of the Department concerned after due verification of the list of the names shall forward it to the Accountant-General (Accounts and Entitlements) for issue of Corrigendum Pension Payment Order.

- (iii) The Corrigendum Pension Payment Order shall be forwarded by the Accountant-General (Accounts and Entitlements) to the Pension Disbursing Officers and a copy of the Corrigendum Pension Payment Order shall also be endorsed to the pensioner.
- (iv) A fresh Pension Payment Order shall be issued by the Accountant-General (Accounts and Entitlements) in respect of the eligible children as and when their turn come up after the death of the pensioner subject to fulfilment of the conditions specified in rule 49(6) of the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules, 1978.
