

Sir,

Sub: Medical Charges - Reimbursement of Medical  
expenses to Government employees - Ceiling  
limit - Revised procedures - Orders issued -  
Clarification - Issued.

Ref: G.O.No.261, Health and Family Welfare  
Department, dated 21-4-1995.

In the order cited, the Government have introduced  
a revised procedure for claiming medical reimbursement by  
Government servants and restricted the claims to one month's  
Basic Pay and Dearness Allowance component on pay as on 1.1.95.

2. It has been represented to the Government to  
consider the medical reimbursement bills presented before  
21-4-95 without restricting the ceiling limit and issue a  
clarification in the matter.

3. The Government after examining the request  
direct that one month's pay plus Dearness Allowance, as on  
1.1.95 ceiling limit operates from 1995-96 onwards and the  
total claims old/new in 1995-96 will be limited to this level.

4. This letter issue with the concurrence of the  
Finance Department - vide its G.O.No. 80494/Sal/95-1,  
dated 21-9-1995.
