MEDICAL AID - Special surgery/treatment assistance to the pensioners under Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme - Procedure for grant of assistance to the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' who are drawing pension from the Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries and under Public Sector Bank scheme outside the State -Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued implementing the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme in respect of State Government pensioners including Teacher pensioners with effect from 1.7.1995. In the Government Order seventh read above, orders have been issued extending the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioner's Health Fund Scheme in respect of the pensioners of All India Services belonging to the Tamil Nadu Cadre with effect from 1.4.1997. According to this scheme, each pensioner shall subscribe a sum of Rs.5/- per annum to the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund. Government will match this with a contribution of Rs.5/- per annum per pensioner. An assistance of Rs.50,000 or 75 % of the actual cost of treatment whichever is less will be given to the State Government pensioners including Teacher pensioners and pensioners of All India Services belonging to the Tamil Nadu Cadre for undergoing certain special surgeries/treatment in certain accredited Institutions in Tamil Nadu. The Accountant General (A&E) Chennai in his letter fifth read above has suggested certain procedure that has to be followed for grant of assistance under the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme

to the Tamil Nadu Government pensioners who are drawing pension from the Treasuries/ Sub-Treasuries and under the Public Sector Bank Scheme outside the State.

2. The Government have carefully examined the procedure suggested by the Accountant General (A&E) Chennai. The Government prescribe the following procedures for grant of assistance under the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme to the Tamil Nadu Government pensioners including Teacher pensioners and pensioners of All India Services belonging to the Tamil Nadu Cadre who are drawing pension from the Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries and under the Public Sector Bank Scheme outside the State:-

- i) The State Government pensioners including Teacher pensioners and pensioners of All India Services belonging to the Tamil Nadu Cadre shall send subscription at the rate of Rs.5/- per annum for a block of 5 years (i.e. Rs.25/- in one lumpsum for five years) commencing from 1995 to 1999 by means of Demand Draft to the Director of Pension, No.807, Anna Salai, Chennai - 600 002. In the event of death of a pensioner during the block year, the balance amount for the remaining period of block year shall be refunded to the family of the deceased pensioner by the Director of Pension.
- ii) The assistance from the fund will be sanctioned to the above pensioners only for undergoing special surgeries/treatment listed out in Annexure I in the accredited institutions indicated in Annexure II to this order. The assistance will not be extended for any other surgeries/treatment taken in other than the accredited hospitals.
- iii) The pensioners who are drawing pension from the Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries and under the Public Sector Bank Scheme outside the State shall send their applications with all original bills and vouchers to the Director of Pension No.807, Anna Salai, Chennai - 600 002.
- iv) On receipt of applications from the pensioners drawing pension outside the State, the Director of Pension, Chennai shall consult the Dean of Chennai Medical College, Chennai-600 003 before sanctioning assistance.
- v) The Director of Pension, Chennai shall sanction the grant of assistance to the pensioners drawing pension outside the State from the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund by means of a Demand Draft directly to the pensioners who are residing in other States.
