on improving promotional prospects of Ministerial  
Categories - Revision of norms - Creation of Certain  
Assistant and Superintendents in the Public Health  
and Preventive Medicine Department - Certain orders  
requested- Regarding.

In the G.O.Ms.No. 662, H&FW, dated 21.5.93, orders were issued  
to the effect that 188 posts of Assistants be upgraded as Superinten-  
dents and 843 posts of Junior Assistants be upgraded as Assistants  
in the Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine. Subsequently  
in the G.O.Ms.No. 759, H&FW, dated 3.6.93 it was ordered that one  
post of Assistant be upgraded as Superintendent and 9 posts of  
Junior Assistants be upgraded as Assistants in the State Health  
Transport Department. The Department of Public Health and Preventive  
Medicine and the Department of Tamil Nadu State Health Transport  
form a single unit for purpose of postings. By the above orders  
out of the 13 Assistants working in the Directorate of Tamil Nadu  
State Health Transport Department, 10 Assistants get promotion as  
Superintendents and are to be posted in Units under the control of  
Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine. Hence a large  
number of senior most persons will be taken away from the Tamil Nadu  
State Health Transport Department and consequently result in dislocation  
of administration in the Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department.  
The Director, Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department has,  
therefore, requested the Government to permit the Director of Public  
Health and Preventive Medicine, to allow the 9 Assistants now working  
in the Directorate of Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department  
to continue in the same office duly upgraded them as Superintendents.  
(Desk Officers) till they get regular vacancy as Superintendents.  
The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has also  
recommended the above request.
