ORDER:

As per G.O.Ms.No.284, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, dated 19-8-1992, Heads of Departments are entitled for the post of Steno-typist Grade-I in the scale of pay of Rs.1600-2600 and Additional Directors and other second level Officers and Joint Directors are entitled for Steno-typist Grade-II in the scale of pay of Rs.1400-2600.

2. The Registrar, High Court, has stated that District Judge Grade-I is in the scale of pay of Rs.5100-5700 and the District Judge Grade-II is in the scale of pay of Rs.4500-5700. The said scales of pay are equivalent to the scales of pay of Directors and Additional Directors in other Government Departments. The Chief Judicial Magistrates and Sub-Judges are in the scale of pay of Rs.3700-5000, equivalent to the scale of pay of Joint Directors in other Government Departments. Hence, the District Judges, Chief Judicial Magistrates and Sub-Judges may be considered as second level officers and the Steno-Typist Grade-III in the scale of pay of Rs.1200-2040 have to be upgraded as Steno-typist Grade-II in the scale of pay of Rs.1400-2600 in the Courts presided by the District Judges, Chief Judicial Magistrates and Sub-Judges. Hence, based on the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.284, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, Chennai, dated 19-8-92, the Registrar, High Court, Chennai has sent the following proposals to the Government for orders:-

- 2) Upgradation of one post of Steno-typist Grade-III as Steno-typist Grade-II in the Official Assignee Office, High Court; and
- 3) Upgradation of one post of Steno-Typist Grade-III as Steno-typist Grade-I in the High Court, Chennai.

3. The Government have examined the recommendation of the High Court, Chennai mentioned in para 2 above and decided to allow only the Steno-typist Grade-II in the scale of pay of Rs. 1400-2600 to the District Judges and allied categories on the existing steno-typists Grade-III in the Subordinate Courts in the Judicial Department. They accordingly sanction the upgradation of 62 (sixty-two) posts of Steno-Typist Grade-III as Steno-typist Grade-II in the Subordinate Courts in the Judicial Department in the scale of pay of Rs. 1400-2600 subject to the condition that the date of effect will be the actual date of filling up of these posts and sufficient number of posts of steno-typists Grade-III should be available for upgradation as Grade-II in the Subordinate Courts.

4. The pay and allowances of the staff consequent on the upgradation of the post should be debited to relevant sub-heads under the major head "2014. Administration of Justice".
