ORDER:

The following Notification will be published in the  
Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to  
Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of TamilNadu  
hereby makes the following amendment to the TamilNadu Pension Rules,  
1978.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come  
into force on the 1st April 1979.

AMENDMENT.

In the said Rules, after rule 49-A, the following rule  
shall be inserted, namely:-

"49-B. Family pension in certain cases not to be governed  
by the Family Pension Rules, 1964:-

(1) Where a Government servant who is not governed  
by the Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Family Pension  
Rules, 1964 dies, --

(a) after completion of not less than one year  
continuous service; or

(b) after retirement from service, the family of  
the deceased Government servant shall be entitled  
to a family pension at a flat rate of Rs.100/- per  
mensem.

(2) Any member of the family of the deceased Government  
servant, who is in receipt of a family pension under any rules  
in force prior to the 1st April 1964, may exercise his option  
to receive family pension under the said rules or under  
sub-rule (1).

(3) Every member of the family of the deceased Government  
Servant, who opts to continue to be governed by the old rules,  
shall be paid a family pension determined by taking together  
the family pension and dearness allowance thereon paid to him  
before the 1st April 1979.


