ORDER

The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules, 1978.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 21st March, 1989.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 34, for the first proviso, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely:-

Provided that the Government shall have no liability for the payment of family pension in such a case except in the case of families of those Government employees who were or are on deputation to the State Public Sector Undertakings or Boards and who were or are permanently absorbed there, in the event of their death during their employment in the State Public Sector Undertaking or Board subject to fulfilment of the following conditions, namely:-

- (i) The families of such deceased employees of the State Public Sector Undertaking or Board shall not receive any other family pension including Employees Family Pension and Life Insurance Scheme;
- (ii) If a pension scheme is under implementation in the State Public Sector Undertaking or Board, the Government will place the required funds at the disposal of the State Public Sector Undertaking or Board on a prorata basis to enable them to grant the family pension to the families of such deceased employees;
- (iii) If there is no pension scheme in the State Public Sector Undertakings or Board, the Government will bear the liability for the payment of family pension to the families of such deceased employees of the State Public Sector Undertaking or Board only in respect of the services put in by the deceased employee under the Government;
