Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Family Security Fund Scheme - Enhancement of pensioners' contribution - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government order first read above as amended in Government Order second read above, orders have been issued implementing the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Family Security Fund Scheme in respect of State Government pensioners including Teacher pensioners and the pensioners of All India Services belonging to the Tamil Nadu Cadre with effect from 01.01.1997. In the Government Order third above, orders have been issued prescribing the procedure for the recovery of pensioners' contribution and the payment of lumpsum amount to the Tamil Nadu Government pensioners including Teacher pensioners and the pensioners of All India Services belonging to the Tamil Nadu cadre who are drawing pension from the Treasuries / Sub-Treasuries and under the Public Sector Bank Scheme outside the State. According to the scheme, the contribution of Rs.20/- p.m. will be deducted from the pension towards the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Family Security Fund Scheme till their death. In the case of death of a pensioner, after contributing for one year to the fund, a sum of Rs.25,000/- will be paid to his spouse and if the spouse is not alive, the amount will be paid to the nominee if specific nomination is filed with the pension disbursing officer failing which to all the legal heirs in equal shares. This is a self supporting scheme to be run on the contribution given by the pensioners.

2. As the inflow to the fund was not sufficient to meet the outflow, the contribution was increased from Rs. 20/- per month to Rs.40/- per month with effect from 01.04.1999 in the Government Order fourth read above and again, the contribution was increased from Rs.40/- per month to Rs.50/- per month with effect from June, 2000, in the Government Order fifth read above.

3. In the reference sixth read above, the Director of Pension has stated that the average monthly claim received for payment is above 600 cases and the amount required for these claim is Rs.1.5 crores per month, whereas the receipt from the pensioners is above Rs.1.15 crores only leaving the deficit of Rs.35 lakhs per month. He has stated that there are about 5,500 cases pending for settlement for want of funds. He has therefore suggested that the existing monthly contribution of Rs.50/- per month may be enhanced to Rs.70/- per month as in the case of contribution fixed for local body pensioners in G.O. Ms. No. 120, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department, dated 20.05.1999.

4. The Government after careful consideration have decided to accept the proposal of Director of Pension to enhance the monthly contribution by the pensioners. The Government accordingly direct that the pensioners contribution towards Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Family Security Fund from the pensioners be increased from Rs.50/- per month to Rs.70/- per month with effect from 01.11.2001 (ie) the pension payable for the month of November, 2001.
