

1. In the G.O. fourth read above, the Government have issued orders that at the time of retirement encashment of leave upto a maximum of 300-days shall be allowed and for this, the Earned Leave accumulated up to 240-days shall be allowed for encashment and Unearned Leave on Private Affairs upto 120-days which shall be converted into 60 days of full pay shall be allowed for encashment. It has also been ordered that encashment of leave salary at the time of retirement shall be based on Pay plus Dearness allowance only and other allowances will not be taken into account.

2. In order to control the cash impact, it is proposed to make payment of 50% of the amount in cash and the balance 50% as Small Savings Certificates. Payment as small Savings Certificates enables the Government to obtain a small saving loan from Government of India only through which the cash to make the payment becomes available. Accordingly the Government direct that in the case of a Government servant who retires on or after the 1st April 2003 encashment leave salary at the time of retirement shall be made 50% in cash and the balance 50% in small savings certificates after obtaining the option of the Government servant to choose either the Post Office Time deposit for three years or the National Savings Certificates (VIII-Issue) for six years.

3. The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309, read with Article 313, of the Constitution of India and all other powers hereunto enabling the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Fundamental Rules:

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force on the 1st April 2003.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Fundamental Rules:-

(1) In rule 86, for sub-rule (a) excluding the Explanation thereunder, the following sub-rule shall be substituted namely:-

(a) (1) Leave to the credit of a Government servant in his leave account other than earned leave and leave on private affairs shall lapse on the date of retirement or on the date of termination of the extension of service, as the case may be. The competent authority (leave sanctioning authority) shall suo motu draw and disburse the cash benefit of encashment of earned leave and leave on private affairs at the credit of the Government servants in Groups B.C and D as 50% in cash and 50% of balance as small savings certificates after obtaining the option of the Government servant to choose either the Post Office Time Deposit for three years or the National Savings Certificate (VIII issued) for six years, without formal sanction orders on the date of retirement or on the date of termination of the extension of service, as the case may be, or on the next working day, following the date of retirement or termination of extension of service if the date of retirement or termination of extension of service happens to be a holiday. In respect of Group A A officers, the Accountant General or Pay and Accounts Officer, as the case may be, shall suo motu issue the pay slips for encashment of earned leave and leave on private affairs, as aforesaid at the credit of the Government servants without formal sanction orders. On the date of retirement or on the date of termination of the extension of service, immediately on retirement or termination of extension of service.

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(ii) The benefit of encashment of earned leave at this credit of Government servant on the date of retirement or on the date of termination of extension of service as the case may be, shall be subject to a maximum of 240-days and be eligible for leave salary which shall ~~which~~ include Pay and Dearness Allowance only for the ntire period of leave at credit.

(iii).The benefit of encashment of leave on private affairs on the date of retirment or on the date of termination of extension of service, as the case may be shall be subject to 50% of the leave on private affairs standing to the credit of the Government servant subject ot a maximum of 60-days with full leave salary which shall include Pay and Dearness Allowance only. While calculating the leave on private affairs for the above purpose, the frattion of half-a-day shall be rounded off to one day".

(2). In APPENDIX I, in ANNEXURE III, under the heading 'The Tamil Nadu Leave Rules, 1933" In rule 7,(i)for sub-rule(i) the following sub-rule shall be substituted namely:-

(1) Leave at the credit of a Government servant in his leave account other than earned leave and leave on private affairs shall lapse on the date of retirement of on the date of termination of the extension of service, as the case may be. The competent authority (Leave sanctioning authority) shall suo motu draw and disburse the cash benefits of encashment servants in Groups B,C and D as 50% in cash and 50% balance as Small Savings Certificates after obtaining the option of the Government servant to choose either the Post Office Time Deposit for three years or the National Savings Certificate (VIII issue) for six years, without formal sanction orders on the date of retirement or on the date of ~~xxxx~~ termination of extension of service, as the case may be, or on the next working day following the date of retirement or termination of extension of s rvicve, if the date of retirement or termination of extension of service happens to be a holiday. In respect of Group A Officers, the Accountant General of Pay and Accounts Officer, as the case may be shall suo motu issue the pay slips for encashment of earned leave and leave on private affairs as aforesaid at the credit of the Government servants without former saction orders on the date of retirement of on the date of termination of extension of servve immediately on retirement or termination of extension of service"

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(ii) for sub-rule (4/iii) excluding the Explanation thereunder the following sub-rule shall be substituted name

(iii). The benefit or encashment of leave on private affairs on the date of retirement or on the date of termination of extension of service as the case may be shall be subject to 50-percent of the leave on private affairs standing to the credit of the Government servant subject ~~xxxx~~ to a maximum of 60 days with full leave salary which shall include pay and Dearness Allowances only. While calculating the leave on private affairs for the above purpose, the fraction of half-a -day shall be rounded off to one day".
