Sub: Arrears due to the employees who retired between 1.1.96 and 31.3.98 - Payment of pay and allowances in respect of those retired from 1.1.96 to 31.3.2004 - Mode of payment - Orders issued - Compliance report - Called for.

I am to invite your attention to the references cited.

In the reference third cited, all the Heads of Departments/Heads of Offices were requested to expedite the payment of first instalment of 60% Pay Commission arrears and send a compliance report to Government on or before 15.3.2005 without fail. But, many Heads of Departments have not sent the compliance report so far. In this connection, I am directed to inform that based on the announcement made in the Budget Speech 2005-2006 Government have issued orders in G.O.Ms.Nos.144 and 145, Finance (PC) Department, dated 13.4.2005 for the payment of the entire balance arrears amount of commutation, death-cum-retirement gratuity and leave salary in respect of those retired between 1.1.96 and 31.3.98 during
