ORDER:

In G.O.Ms.No.482 Health dated 12.3.86 the Government Sanctioned the construction of buildings for the upgraded Primary Health Centre, Chennimalai in Periyar District. The Director of Primary Health Centres has stated that the buildings with 24 bedded ward, operation theatre, Blood Bank and X-Ray Block were completed by the Public Works Department at a cost of Rs.14.00 lakhs, including a donation of Rs.2.50 lakhs by the Chennimalai Weavers Co-operative Society. The buildings were taken over by the Medical Officer, Primary Health Centre, Chennimalai on 21.5.88. The Director of Primary Health Centres has, therefore requested the Government to sanction the additional staff (Technical and Non-Technical) and equipments etc.

2. The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Director of Primary Health Centres and sanction the employment of the additional staff mentioned in the Annexure I to this order in the Upgraded Primary Health Centre, Chennimalai, in Periyar District temporarily for a period of one year from the date of employment in the scale of pay noted against each post.

3. The staff sanctioned in para 2 above is in addition to their pay are eligible for Dearness Allowance, House Rent Allowance and other allowances permissible as per the rules and orders in force from time to time.

4. The Government also sanction the recurring and Non-recurring expenditure mentioned in Annexure II to this order to the Primary Health Centre, Chennimalai, in Periyar District.
