

I am directed to invite your attention to the
references cited.

2. Based on the orders of the XI Asst. Judge, City
Civil Court, Madras in I.A.No.19271/94 in O.S.No.6355/94,
dated, 9.1.95, in the Government reference 1st cited,
instructions have been issued to all Heads of Department
to recognise Thiru K.Kaliaperumal as the President (i/c)
of the Tamil Nadu Government Officials' Union.

3. Subsequently, based on the judgement of the High
Court, Madras, in CRP No.203/95, dated, 8.8.95 setting
aside the orders of the XI Judge in I.A.No.19271 of 94,

the orders issued in the letter 1st cited recognising Thiru Kaliaperumal as President (i/c) of the Union have been cancelled in the Government letter 3rd cited. Based on the observations of the High Court in the said C.R.P. the Heads of Department have been informed in the same letter that Thiru S.Ariivukkarasu will function as President (i/c) of the said Union, till elections are conducted to elect the office bearers of the Union.

4. The Supreme Court of India, while dismissing the S.L.P. in No.19817/95, dated, 15.9.95, filed by Thiru K. Kaliaperumal, has made the following observations:-

"Dismissed. It is however, made clear that observations made in the order under appeal and the findings therein, if any, are confined only to the disposal of the matter before the High Court, which is of inter-locutory nature, and shall not affect the merits of the issue."

5. The Government, taking into account the orders of the Supreme Court of India and after a thorough examination of the matter, in consultation with the Government Pleader, High Court, Madras, hereby direct that the instructions issued in the Government letter 3rd cited, to the effect that Thiru S.Ariivukkarasu would function as President (i/c) of the Tamil Nadu Government Officials' Union, be cancelled.
