

ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, orders have been issued implementing the Tamil Nadu Government Employees' Special Provident Fund-cum-Gratuity Scheme with effect from 1-4-1984. According to rule 11, of the said scheme, the Director of Treasuries and Accounts is the administrator of the scheme. In the G.O. second read above, orders have been issued delegating powers to the Director of Treasuries and Accounts to accord sanction for refunding the amount from Government account in respect of the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Special Provident Fund-cum-Gratuity Scheme in respect of former Government employees who were absorbed in the State Owned Corporations/Boards. In Government letter third read above, instructions have been issued to the Director of Treasuries and Accounts to sanction the refund of Special Provident Fund subscription together with interest to the Government employees who have been absorbed in the Central Government also..

2. In the G.O. fourth read above, orders have been issued empowering the Directorate of Pension to take over the work on settlement of Special Provident Fund from the Treasuries and Accounts Department..

3. The Director of Pension in his letter fourth read above has sent proposals to the Government to delegate the powers to the competent authority in the last station where the subscriber had served before deputation and that the competent authority may be empowered to sanction refund of Special Provident Fund Subscription together with interest from the Government account based on the strength of the recovery particulars maintained by the drawing officers in respect of the Government employees who were absorbed in the State Government owned Corporations/Boards..

4. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Pension and decided to accept it. Accordingly, they direct that the Heads of Offices/Heads of Departments be delegated.
