ORDER:

The following instructions are issued to the appointing authorities for issue of order of reinstatement in service and regulation of the period of absence from duty up to the date of death of employees who were served with dismissal / suspension orders for participation in the July, 2003 strike:-

- a) The appointing authority shall issue a deemed order for revocation of the suspension/dismissal as the case may be and another deemed order of reinstatement of the deceased employee effective on the date prior to the date of death.
- b) The period from 1.7.2003 in the case of employees of Secretariat and from 2.7.2003 in the case of other employees till the date of death of the employee shall be treated as duty.
- c) The appointing authority shall issue an order that the employee has died while in service and that the date of his death shall be treated as on duty as per rule 5(2) of the Pension Rules.
