



ABSTRACT

Public Service - Announcement of Hon'ble Chief Minister of cancellation of all the punishments imposed on Government employees and Teachers for participation in the indefinite strike from 2.7.2003 in violation of the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Essential Services Maintenance Act, 2002- Withdrawal of all the disciplinary cases initiated under the Act - Orders issued.

ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister in the Government Press Release dated 18.05.2004, has announced, among other things, that the Government Employees Associations and Teachers Organisations misled by some political parties had entered on a strike in July, 2003 and that as per her announcement in the Legislative Assembly on 10.2.2004 all the employees and teachers had been reinstated in service on compassionate grounds. She has also announced that with a view to improve the relationship of the Government employees and Teachers with the Government and with a hope that the employees and teachers would serve the people with dedication and enthusiasm, the Government have decided to cancel all punishments imposed on Government employees and teachers who participated in the strike in July, 2003 and to withdraw all the disciplinary cases pending against them.

2. In pursuance of the above announcements, the Government direct that:-

- a) All orders imposing the punishments of dismissal and reduction in rank have already been modified as punishments of stoppage of increment for four years and two years respectively as per the Government orders in G.O.Ms.No.12,P&AR(K)Dept, Dated 11.2.2004. Now, all orders imposing the punishments compulsory retirement, stoppage of increment for one year/two/three/four years with or without cumulative effect, censure, admonition or any other

punishment on the Government employees and teachers for the offences under the Tamil Nadu Essential Services Maintenance Act, 2002 as amended by Tamil Nadu Ordinance 3 of 2003 shall be treated as cancelled with immediate effect.

- b) All disciplinary cases, including the First Information Reports, filed by the appointing authorities against the Government employees and teachers under the Tamil Nadu Essential Services Maintenance Act, 2002 as amended by Tamil Nadu Ordinance 3 of 2003 and still pending shall be treated as withdrawn with immediate effect.
