In continuation of the instructions/guidelines issued on the above subject in the references cited, I am directed to issue the following further instructions in the matter.:-

"Whenever orders promoting or transferring a Medical Officer or any staff are issued in a single Government Order or in any proceedings and if the Medical Officer or staff so promoted or transferred joins in the new station within the joining time and in case the Medical Officer or staff so promoted or transferred under a particular Government Order or proceedings appear for transfer counselling, in such cases only CML seniority in the case of Medical Officers and service seniority in the case of other staff will be the criteria for priority rather than station seniority".
