Claiming of lodging charges - Inclusion
of Luxury tax - Instructions - Issued.

In the reference cited, the Principal Commissioner, Commissioner of Commercial Taxes has stated that while on official tour outside the State wherever Government accommodation is not available, Government servants have to stay in hotels or lodges. Therefore, the employees have to actually pay the lodging charges plus luxury tax. The Commissioner has further stated that the bill is audited by the Pay and Accounts Officer on the ground that Luxury tax cannot be claimed. He has therefore requested the Government to issue orders allowing luxury tax to be claimed by Government employees.

2. The Government have decided to accept the above request of the Principal Commissioner and Commissioner of Commercial Taxes and accordingly direct that while claiming lodging charges in the Travelling Allowance bills, Government employees may also claim luxury tax actually paid subject to the condition that lodging charges plus luxury tax should not exceed the daily allowance permitted for that locality.
