ORDER

In the Government orders read above, 93 Primary Health Centres have been upgraded as 30 bedded Primary Health Centres. While upgrading the main Primary Health Centres, twenty additional Primary Health Centres were also upgraded as 30 bedded Primary Health Centres. In the main Primary Health Centres, Senior Civil Surgeon / Civil Surgeon, Ministerial Staff, BHS, Community Health Nurse, Ophthalmic Assistant posts are available and the drawing and disbursing power is given to the Medical Officer in charge of the Main Primary Health Centres and a vehicle is provided to the Main Primary Health Centre. In the additional Primary Health Centre above staff and other facilities are not available and administrative and technical problems will arise when the additional Primary Health Centres are put to function as upgraded Primary Health Centres. Hence the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has suggested that additional Primary Health Centres which have been upgraded may be declared as Main Primary Health Centres of the Block.

2. The list of additional Primary Health Centres which are upgraded as 30 bedded Primary Health Centre and the Primary Health Centres which are hitherto functioning as Main Primary Health Centre in the Block is given below:-

3. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has therefore proposed to declare the 20 additional Primary Health Centres mentioned in para two above as main Primary Health Centres, to transfer the posts mentioned in para one above from the main Primary Health Centre to the upgraded additional Primary Health Centres, to entrust drawing and administrative powers to the Medical Officer in charge of the Upgraded Primary Health Centres and to instruct the Director of Family Welfare and Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homeopathy to transfer the Family Welfare wing and Siddha wing to the upgraded Primary Health Centres.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and decided to accept it. Accordingly they issue the following orders:-

- Hereafter, the 20 additional Primary Health Centres mentioned in para 1 above which are upgraded as 30 bedded Primary Health Centre be declared as Main Primary Health Centre of the Block. The 20 Primary Health Centres hitherto functioning as Main Primary Health Centre in the Block shall hereafter be called as Additional Primary Health Centres.
- Government direct that the following posts now available in the main Primary Health Centres be transferred to the upgraded Primary Health Centres along with the vehicles and drivers with immediate effect.

- Ministerial Staff

- 3) Block Health Supervisor
- 4) Community Health Nurse
- 5) Ophthalmic Assistant

- c) Government direct that drawing and disbursing powers and administrative powers be given to the Medical Officer of the above upgraded Primary Health Centres.
- d) Government also direct that Family Welfare and the Siddha Wings now available in the above main Primary Health Centres be transferred to the upgraded additional Primary Health Centres. (Now declared as Main Primary Health Centres)

5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Director of Family Welfare and Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homeopathy are requested to take necessary follow up action to implement the orders of the Government in para 4 above and send a report to the Government early.
