**ORDER:**

The staff working in minor ports viz. Nagapattinam  
Cuddalore and Tuticorin Municipalities in connection with  
quarantine work and the port Health Assistant, in the Office  
of the Director of public Health and preventive Medicine  
Madras are not getting their pay since October 1976. The  
Government of India have now requested this Government=  
that the concerned staff working in minor ports may be  
paid their salaries etc. since October 1976 out of the  
budget of the State Government and that thereafter the  
State Government may obtain reimbursement from the Govt.  
of India. The Director of public Health and preventive  
Medicine has also recommended the proposal.

2. The Government accept the proposal of the Govt.  
of India and hereby issue an express order to the Treasury  
Officer, Nagapattina, Cuddalore and Tuticorin to honour  
the pay bills as and when presented by the Municipal Health  
Officers Nagapattinam, Cuddalore and Tuticorin.

The expenditure on pay and allowances of the staff  
referred to in para 1 above will be initially met by the  
State Government and finally get reimbursed from the  
Government of India.

4. The expenditure on pay and allowances and  
contingencies of the Headquarters staf (One Assistant,  
Office of the Director of public Health and preventive  
Medicine, Madras) should be drawn under the Headquarters  
Administration Head \*282 A public Health and Sanitation  
A-Direction and Administration - I. Non plan - AA.  
Headquarters Administration.

5. The expenditure on pay and allowances and contin-  
gencies should be drawn by the Municipal Health Officers  
concerned under \*282.A public Health and Sanitation -  
a-Direction and Administration - I. Non plan - AB. Mofussal  
Administration.

6. The Director of public Health and preventive  
Medicine, is requested to take necessary action, to  
claim reimbursement from Government of India.
