



Sub: Pension - Reduction in the maximum qualifying service for full pension orders issued - Clarifications Issued.

- Ref: 1) G.O.Ms.No.461, Finance (Pension) Department, dated 31.7.1996.
2) From the Principal Accountant General (Accounts and Entitlements), Chennai D.O. letter No.Pr.AG (A&E) PMI/III/3-4/96-97/317, dated: 9.9.1996.

I am directed to clarify the points raised with reference to the G.C. first cited as follows:-

S.No.	Points raised.	Clarifications issued.

1.	Whether these orders are applicable to the employees of Local Bodies and Aided Educational Institutions.	This is under examination and separate orders will be issued.
2.	Whether the proportionate pension for less than 30 years has to be calculated hereafter at pay last drawn $X \frac{50}{100} X$ Service in half years (Maximum 60)	Yes.
3.	The procedure/method that has to be followed/adopted for calculation of DCRG for a qualifying service of 30 years upto 33 years and also to Service less than 30 years.	The qualifying service for entitlement for full pension shall be 30 years. In respect of calculation of DCRG, the existing formula as provided in rule 45(c) of the Tamilnadu Pension Rules 1978 viz. one-fourth of the emoluments last drawn for each completed six months period of qualifying service shall continue.

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i.e. those who have rendered 30 years of qualifying service are eligible for 15 months of emoluments last drawn and those with a qualifying service of 31, 32, & 33 are eligible for 15½, 16 and 16½ times of emoluments last drawn as DCRG.

Accordingly, there shall be no change in the existing procedure for calculation of DCRG.

4. The procedure/method that has to be followed for allowing weightage in respect of cases of voluntary retirement arising on or after 1.7.1996.

Orders in this regard will be issued by Personnel and Administrative Reforms (FR) Department.

5. Whether reduction of maximum qualifying service to 30 years is applicable to the persons who retired prior to 1.7.96 also with financial benefit from 1.7.96.

The reduction of maximum qualifying service to 30 years is not applicable to the persons who retire prior to 1.7.96.
