

ORDER:

In Government Memorandum No.1589/52-2, Public (Services.C) Department, dated.30.4.1952, instructions were issued to the effect that all Government servants should reside within the limit of their Headquarters/ Stations and whenever Government servants find it necessary to live outside the prescribed headquarters, they should obtain the specific sanction of the Head of the Office or the competent authority, as the case may be and that permission to reside outside the headquarters should be granted only in exceptional cases, each case being considered on its merits and in accordance with administrative convenience.

2. In G.O.Ms.No.46, Personnel and Administrative Reforms(Per.A) Department, dated. 12.1.80, the above instructions were once again brought to the notice of the Secretaries to Government and Heads of Department and they were requested to see that the above instructions were strictly complied with.

3. The President, Tamil Nadu Government Officials Union has requested that the employees may be allowed to reside within 100 KMS. from the Headquarters in view of increasing population and lack of sufficient housing accommodation. The Government after careful consideration, permit the Government servants posted in Madras City to reside within the limits of 50 KMS. radius of Madras City. In respect of the Headquarters of Districts, the status quo shall continue.
