Establishment - Office of the District Health Officers - Audit Staff  
for auditing work of Primary Health Centres - sanctioned.

Order

At present there are 379 Primary Health Centres in the State. Two Primary Health Centres are yet to be opened to achieve the target of establishment of atleast one Primary Health Centre per block. The budget allotment for administration of Primary Health Centres is about Rs.2.00 crores per annum. A proposal to provide each Primary Health Centre with additional drugs worth about 2,000/- per annum during 1974-75 over and above the present average expenditure of Rs.8,200/- per annum, is under consideration of the Government. A minimum of six beds are provided in each Primary Health Centre and the rate of diet charges is Rs.1.50/- per day per patient. The audit of the Primary Health Centre is at present done by the two audit parties in the Directorate of Health Services and Family Planning. As these audit parties are doing audit on random basis and long after the date of payment of the purchase and as there must be proper control over the institutions, the Director of Health Services and Family Planning has proposed the creation of 13 Districts Audit Parties consisting of one Assistant and two Junior Assistants each.

2.The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Health Services and Family Planning and they consider that eleven audit parties will be sufficient as the work relating to both the Nilgiris District and Coimbatore District can be attended to by one party and similarly the work in Kanyakumari District and Tirunelveli District can be looked after by one party. They accordingly sanction eleven District Audit Parties consisting of one Assistant and two Junior Assistants ~~xxx~~, ~~ix~~ each, temporarily, from the date of taking charge of the staff till 28.2.1975 (inclusive) on the usual scales of pay and allowances for the eleven offices of the District Health Officers for auditing the work of the Primary Health Centres.

3.The expenditure should be debited to the head under "282.A Public Health-Sanitation a Direction and Administration - Non Plan A3 Mofussil administration. "The Director of Health Services and Family Planning is informed that the staff sanctioned in para 2 above should be employed from 1.4.1974 only.
