



in the grade of Senior Entomologist. After absorbing the existing 18 Senior Entomologists in the Zonal and District level, one more post of Senior Entomologist will be required. On account of the implementation of the Modified Plan, the staff which are found surplus in various categories will be absorbed to the extent possible and the remaining will be retrenched. Based on the Modified Plan of Operations, the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has submitted proposals. The Government have examined the proposals and direct that the Modified Plan of Operation be implemented in Tamil Nadu with effect from 1.1.1977 as per the staffing pattern approved by the Government of India.

3. The Government sanction the location of the five Zonal Offices in the following places with the jurisdiction of the districts indicated against them:-

4. Sanction is accorded to the upgrading of the existing post of Assistant Director (Malaria) into that of Joint Director (Malaria) at Headquarters on the scale of pay of Rs. 1500-75-1800 plus Dearness Allowance and other allowances admissible under the rules plus a non-practising allowance of Rs. 300/- p.m. (Rupees Three hundred only), for a period of one year from the date of appointment.

5. Sanction is also accorded to the creation of two posts of Zonal Officers in the grade of Assistant Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine, on the scale of pay of Rs. 1400-50-1400 plus non-practising allowance of Rs. 100/- p.m. and one post of Senior Entomologist, on the scale of pay of Rs. 525-25-600-30-690-35-900 p.m. for a period of one year from

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of employment. They will be eligible to draw Dearness Allowance and other allowances admissible under the rules.

6. Sanction is also accorded for the creation of 10 posts of Laboratory Assistants on Rs. 160-5-240, and 10 posts of District Collectors on Rs. 150-4-170-5-225, and 14 posts of Storekeepers on Rs. 210-5-245-10-325/p.m. and 28 posts of Cleaners on Rs. 130-3-160-4-180-5-195 p.m. all with special allowances admissible under the rules. No appointments should be made afresh but these posts should be filled up by absorbing the existing staff as indicated in the Annexure.

7. The Government direct that the existing three posts of Special Supervisory Unit Officers be redesignated as Special Supervisory Unit Officers (Malaria) and that the existing two posts of Supervisory Unit Officers at Salem and Thiruchengode be redesignated.

8. The surplus staff will be absorbed/retrenched to the extent necessary as indicated against the categories of staff mentioned in the Annexure. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is requested to take action to absorb/retrench the surplus staff and send detailed report to the Government.

9. The Collectors, who are presiding over the District Government Councils, are requested to review the malaria programme also during such meetings.

(a) In respect of Headquarters and Zonal staff, the expenditure should be debited to the sub head: "282. A. Public Health and Sanitation - b. Prevention and control of diseases - c. Malaria in the Fifth Five Year Plan - VII. Centrally Sponsored Schemes - Malaria Control Headquarters (DP Code 282 - ASA.8)".

(b) In respect of District level staff, the expenditure should be debited to "280. Medical - A. Allopathy - b. Relief - I. Non-Plan - Schemes under the control of Director of Health Services and Family Planning - B.K. Basic Staff in Primary Health Centres".
