

**Abstract:** Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project--Rural Health Services Component-Phase IV--Implementation in Tirunelveli and Part of North Arcot(viz) Vellore Health Unit District-Additional staff & other items of expenditure in Health Unit Districts--Orders issued.

**ORDER:**

The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has stated that Phase IV of the Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project is to be implemented in Tirunelveli district having 2 Health Unit Districts and in the Vellore Health Unit District of North Arcot District. Thus, three Health Unit districts will be covered under Phase IV of the project. The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has sent proposal for sanction of staff and other items of expenditure for Phase IV at the Health Unit District level as below:-

2. The Project Coordinator, Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project, Madras has recommended that the pattern adopted for Phase III may be adopted for Phase IV also in respect of staff & other items of expenditure and placed the proposal before the Empowered Committee. The Empowered Committee has accepted the proposal as recommended by the Project Coordinator, Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project.

3. The Government accord for the appointment of staff in each of the three Health Unit District as detailed below under Rural Health Services Component as part of PHASE IV of the Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project for a period of one year from the date of this order or the need therefore ceases whichever is earlier:-

4. The staff will be eligible for Dearness Allowance & Other Allowances at the rates admissible to them under the order in force from time to time.

5. The Government also sanction the following items of expenditure both recurring & non-recurring for each of the three Health Unit Districts:-

<u>Non-recurring:</u>	<u>Amount for each Health Unit District:</u>
1. Furniture (3 Units)	Rs. 5000/- (Rs. five thousand only) per Unit.
2. Typewriter (3 Nos. )	To be supplied by Director of Stationery & Printing, Madras.
3. Duplicator (3 Nos. )	-do-
4. Calculator (3 Nos. )	-do-

Recurring:-

Stationery & Contingencies: Rs. 5000/- for each Health Unit district per annum.

6. The Director of Stationery & Printing, Madras is requested to supply the typewriters, Duplicators & Calculators to the three Health Unit Districts free of cost. They should be handed by qualified persons and returned to the Director of Stationery and Printing when no longer required.

7. The Government also direct that the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine should follow the procedure for purchase of furniture and stationery items sanctioned in paragraph 5 above as per the orders in force.

8. The expenditure should be debited to, "282. Public Health-Sanitation & Water Supply-A. Public Health & Sanitation-AH. Health Education & Publicity--Schemes in the Sixth Five Year Plan--II. State Plan-JC. Tamilnadu Nutrition Project" (D.P. Code 282A AHJC 0007).

9. This order issues with the approval of Empowered Committee constituted in G.O.Ms.No.959 Social Welfare dt.17.12.80 & therefore does not require the concurrence of Finance Department.
