**ABSTRACT:** Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project--Rural Health Services Component--Phase V--Implementation in Chengalpattu and Part of North Arcot District (viz., Cheyyar & Tiruvannamalai Health Unit District) Additional staff in the Health Unit District--Sanctioned--Orders issued.

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ORDER:

The Project Coordinator, Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project, Madras has stated that the Phase V of the Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project is to be implemented in Chengalpattu and Part of North Arcot Districts. In Chengalpattu there are 2 Health Unit Districts (i) Chengalpattu (South Zone) with Headquarters at Kancheepuram and (ii) Chengalpattu (North Zone) with Headquarters at Saidapet. In North Arcot District there are 3 Health Unit Districts with Headquarters at Vellore, Cheyyar and Tiruvannamalai. Government have already issued orders to cover Vellore Health Unit District during Phase IV of the Project. Accordingly orders were issued sanctioning the additional staff for Vellore Health Unit district. She has also stated that the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has submitted proposals for sanction of additional staff and other items of expenditure for Cheyyar & Tiruvannamalai Health Unit Districts, where Phase V of the project is to be implemented.

The Project Corordinator, Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project has recommended that the pattern adopted during Phase IV may be adopted in the case of Phase V also for the purchase of sanction of staff and other items of expenditure to each of the 4 Health Unit Districts at Kancheepuram & Saidapet (in Chengalpattu district) and at Tiruvannamalai and Cheyyar (in North Arcot district) and placed the proposal before the Empowered Committee with modifications. The Empowered Committee which considered the proposal has accepted it.

3. The Government accord sanction for creation of the following posts for each of the 4 Health Unit Districts at Kancheepuram and Saidapet in Chengalpattu District and Tiruvannamalai and Cheyyar in North Arcot District for a period of one year from the date of this order or till the need therefore ceases whichever is earlier.

4. The staff will be eligible for Dearness Allowance & Other allowances at the rates admissible to them under the orders in force from time to time.

5. The Government also accord sanction for the following items of recurring & non-recurring expenditure for the offices of the District Health Unit Districts at Kancheepuram, Saidapet in Chengalpattu district & Tiruvannamalai & Cheyyar in North Arcot District.

6. The Director of Stationery & Printing, Madras is requested to supply the Typewriters, Duplicators & Calculators to the four Health Unit Districts free of cost. They should be handled by qualified persons and returned to the Director of Stationery & Printing when no longer required.

7. The Government also direct that the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine should follow the usual procedure of purchase of furniture and stationery items sanctioned in paragraph 5 above as per the orders in force.

8. The Expenditure should be debited to "282. Public Health-Sanitation & Water Supply--A. Public Health & Sanitation--A.H. Health Education & Publicity--Schemes in the Sixth Five Year Plan--II. State Plan JC. Tamilnadu Nutrition Project"(D.P.Code 282A AHJC 0007).

9. This order issues with the approval of Empowered-Committee constituted in G.O.Ms.No.959 Social Welfare dated 17.12.80 and therefore does not require the concurrence of Finance Department.
