ORDER:

The Government of India, among other components, have sanctioned the upgradation of 16 Primary Health Centres for Tamil Nadu providing central assistance to the tune of Rs. 18.04 lakhs (Rs. 15.84 lakhs towards recurring expenditure, Rs. 1-20 lakhs for non-recurring expenditure and Rs. 1-00 lakhs for the purchase of drugs) for the year 1993-94 under National Programme for Control of Blindness. The Project Director, National Programme for Control of Blindness has sent proposal to Government for identification of 16 Primary Health Centres, posting of one Ophthalmic Assistant in each Primary Health Centre and purchase of drugs etc.,

2. Based on the approval of the Empowered Committee constituted for National Programme for Control of Blindness in G.O.Ms.No. 1278, Health, dated 28.9.93, the Government accord sanction for the following:-

- 1) to identify 16 Primary Health Centres under National Programme for Control of Blindness as shown

in the Annexure -I to this order and to post one Ophthalmic Assistant in each of the identified Primary Health Centres in the Scale of pay of Rs. 1350-30-1440-40-1800-50-2200 plus usual allowances.

2) to accord sanction for incurring the expenditure for the purchase of ophthalmic equipments as shown in the Annexure-II to this order.

3) to authorise the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Madras - 6 to incur the expenditure.

3. The expenditure shall be debited to "2210-Medical and Public Health - 101- Prevention and Control of Blindness Scheme in the Eighth Five Year Plan-III. Centrally sponsored - SD - Prevention and control of Diseases" (DP Code No. 2210-06 - 101-SD - 0008).
