ORDER:

The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has stated that control of Japanese Encephalities is a major Public Health Programme. If Japanese Encephalities is not controlled, the result will be the death of children. At present, action is taken on an adhoc basis for the control of Japanese Encephalities. This not only renders ineffective all control measures required for Japanese Encephalities but also disrupts other programme activities. The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine is therefore of the view that it is necessary that regular anti Japanese Encephalities measures are carried out by spraying with larvicide and adulticides under Technical Supervision by a control unit. The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has further stated that the staff for monitoring unit at headquarters and control unit for Villupuram will be filled up by (i) Redeployment of Staff and (ii) Surrendering surplus staff from other schemes.

2. As regards control unit at the Headquarters, the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has proposed to create one post of Chief Entomologist, Entomological Assistant, Assistant and Typist in lieu of surrendering

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Five posts of Health Supervisors sanctioned under Plague Control measures mentioned in the G.O. second read above and last continued in the G.O. fifth read above. Further the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has proposed to fill up one post of Laboratory Assistant and Four posts of Field Assistants and one post of Driver on redeployment basis.

3. As regards, the Japanese Encephalities Control Unit at Villupuram Ramasamy Padayachair District, the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has proposed to create one post of Entomological Assistant in lieu of surrendering two posts of Health Supervisors sanctioned under Plague scheme in the G.O. second read above and last continued in the G.O. fifth read above. The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has also proposed to fill up the four posts of Field Assistants, one post of Laboratory Assistant and one post of Driver on redeployment basis.

4. The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine. The Government permit the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine to establish the Monitoring Unit at Headquarters and Control Unit at Villupuram for the effective implementation of Japanese Encephalities Control Programme.

5. The Government sanction the creation of posts as detailed in the annexure to this order temporarily for a period of one year from the date of filling up of posts or till the need therefor ceases whichever is earlier.

6. The Government permit the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine to redeploy the following posts for the Establishment of Japanese Encephalities Monitoring Unit at Headquarters and the Japanese Encephalities Control Unit at Villupuram Ramasamy Padayachair District as detailed below:-

(i) Out of 5 posts of Laboratory Assistants sanctioned in the G.O. third read above and last continued in the G.O. fifth read above, 2 posts of Laboratory Assistants (one each from Trichy and Vellore) shall be redeployed to the Japanese Encephalities Monitoring Unit at Headquarters and Japanese Encephalities Control Unit at Villupuram Ramasamy Padayachair District.

(ii) Out of sixty(60) posts of Field Assistants sanctioned in the G.O. first read above and last continued in the G.O. fifth read above under Guinea Worm Eradication Programme, eight posts of Field Assistants shall be redeployed i.e. 4 posts for Japanese Encephalities Monitoring Unit at Headquarters and 4 posts for Japanese Encephalities Control Unit at Villupuram Ramasamy Padayachair District.

(iii) Out of 3 posts of Drivers sanctioned in the G.O. first read above and last continued in the G.O. fifth read above under Guinea Worm Eradication Programme 2 posts of driver shall be redeployed i.e. 1 post of Driver for Japanese Encephalities Monitoring Unit at Headquarters and one post of Driver for the Japanese Encephalities Control Unit at Villupuram Ramasamy Padayachair District.

7. Sanction is accorded for incurring a sum of Rs.5.25 lakhs (Rupees five lakhs and twenty five thousand only) as recurring expenditure towards the purchase of larvicides and adulticides and a sum of Rs.0.92 lakhs (Rupees ninety two thousand only) as non recurring expenditure towards machineries and equipments.

8. The expenditure shall be debited to "2210 Medical and Public Health-06, Public Health-101, Prevention and Control of Diseases-Schemes in the VIII Five Year Plan-II, State Plan JQ Control of Japanese Encephalities 24 Material and Supplies (DPC 2210-06-101 JQ 2401) 19 machinery and equipments (DPC 2210-06-101 JQ 1902).
